From the Training we are having here, I have planted a Church in a village called Eba-Osdan. But I have a challenge in the area of finances, sometime things can be difficult for me and my family that we would cry to God for help. Most times, my sending Mission is really trying her best to give a little support but this cannot be compared to the avalanche of needs that can crop-in at any time. was in this situation when my son got admission to an accredited private Polytechnic in the City of Ibadan. How this boy got admission to study that particular course was amazing. I was partly very happy, as this would give him opportunity to progress in his career. But I was also confused as a mother as to how I and the father would shoulder the enormous responsibilities of a private institution. I felt disturbed and unhappy as the day of resumption draws closer, yet there was nothing on ground in terms of provision for him. I almost abandoned the work by trying to look for a pay Job, at least, to cushion the effect. However, I brought the case to the notice of my sending Mission. They assisted as little as they could but there were still pending issues unsolved. But, my sending Mission Pastor uttered a statement that made me to share this testimony. He said, 'if you are doing the work of God in Eba -Odan where we planted a church through the training of MNM, then God would attend to my matter.' I took the word of the servant of the Lord with faith and I continued my work at Eba-Odan as a planter.

Suddenly a family friend, who knew about my predicament approached me that my son should apply for a Scholarship in that school as soon as he resume academic works and prayerfully he might be taken. So my son applied and sat for the scholarship exam. He was later shortlisted for oral interview and was granted scholarship in the institution where I did not know anybody! This is incredible! God settled me in a big way. Now my son named Kolawole Olalere is on Scholarship in one of the prestigious Polytechnics in Osun State, Nigeria.

od saw my inability but brought across my way His CAPABILITIES into the situation - I give Him praise. I would forever be grateful to my sending Mission that sent me to Eba-Odan for the work of Church planting, and to MNM for sending us out to do what God would like, which is soul winning and Church planting. Honestly, the training is for my good!"



 - We praise God for the provision of funds to propagate the glad tidings of our Lord Jesus through LLJ and her sponsors.


